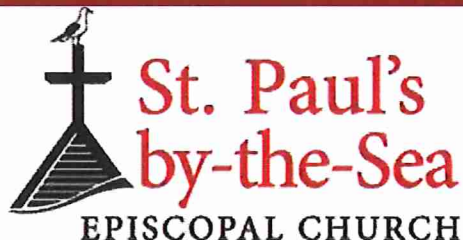

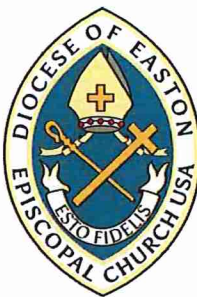

Santosh Marray, Assistant Bishop, Diocese of Alabama; and Rev. John A. Mennell, Rector, St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Montclair, New Jersey.
