Macaroni and Cheese boxes



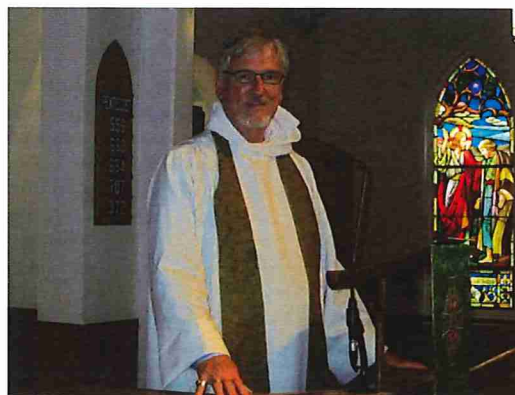
The Right Reverend Santosh "San" Marray was elected the 11th Bishop of Easton on Saturday, June 11, 2016 at Trinity Episcopal Cathedral in Easton. Bishop Marray was one of four nominees presented to the Special Convention of the Diocese for consideration for election. Marray was elected on the third ballot when he received a majority of the clergy delegates and lay delegates votes.

Marray is currently serving at the Assistant Bishop for the Diocese of Alabama. Bishop Marray, who was born in Guyana, has previously served as the

Bishop of the Seychelles in the Indian Ocean and Bishop Assisting for the Diocese of East Carolina prior to his current appointment in the Diocese of Alabama.

Bishop Marray will be installed by Presiding Bishop Michael Curry on Saturday, October 15 at Chesapeake College.

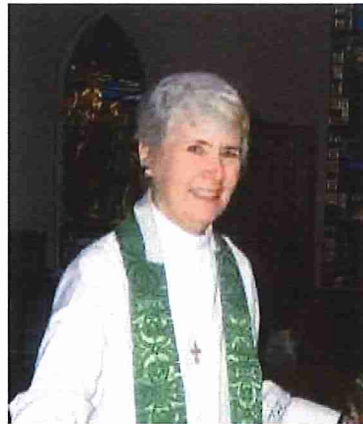
This Sunday, June 19, we welcome Fr. Rusty Hesse as our supply priest at St. Paul's by-the-Sea. Fr. Rusty will be
