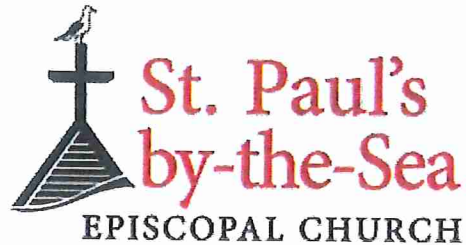

The following items are always needed and always welcome:

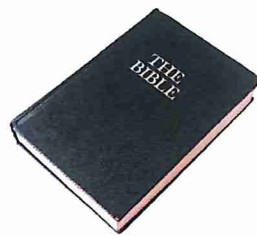
Tuna - packed in water - 5 oz. cans

select a Senior Warden, Junior Warden, and Registrar. Suzy Young, who is not a member of the Vestry, will continue in her role as Treasurer.

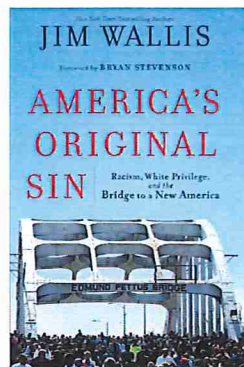
