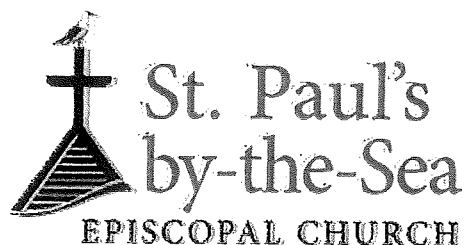

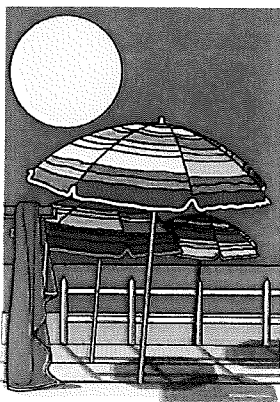

The HVAC unit is in the process of being moved from the top of the boiler room to the rooftop of Dewees Hall. This past week, the freon was drained from the unit in preparation for its move next week. The air conditioning should be operational by next Sunday, June 18.

Another change in Dewees Hall involves the two large wooden mobile counters that house the 6'x8' tables. The one-way rollers have been converted to plastic silicone sliders to enable the units to be moved in any direction without damaging the floors. Thank you Don for this improvement!

An Update on Altar Flowers

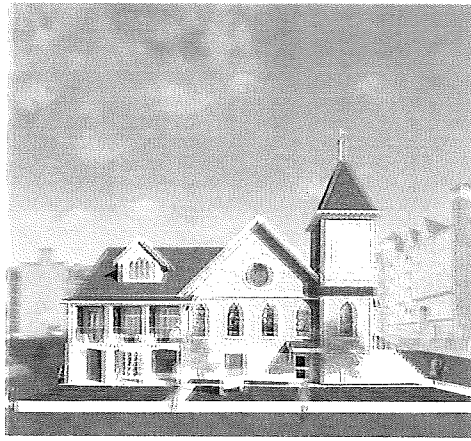

The barrier wall in the undercroft has been erected. Interior demolition has begun and should be completed in a couple of weeks.

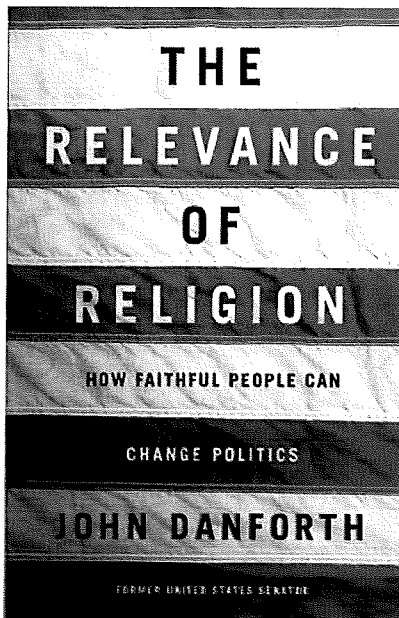
The new hall bathroom should be completed the week of June 18th if all the
