Statement from Presiding Bishop Michael Curry on the passing of Gen. Colin Powell, former Secretary of State

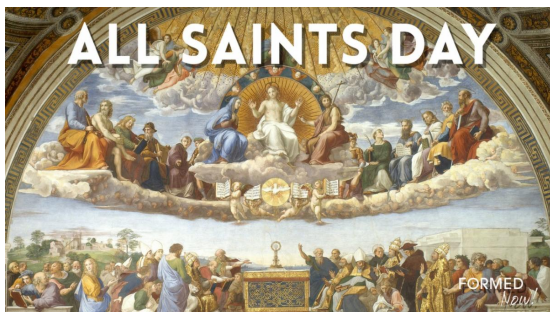

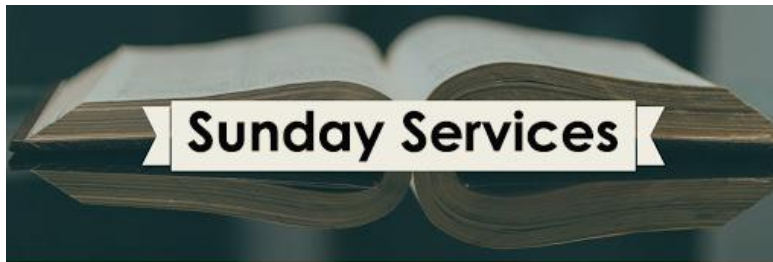
