## **Notes from Meeting with Bishop Marray**

Bob Rothermel and I met with Bishop Santosh Marray on Wednesday, September 21, 2022 at Bray House in Easton. We updated the Bishop on our parish's road to recovery since August of 2020. He commended us on our journey of healing and recovery that has led us to our current state of parish vitality.



We updated the Bishop on our Clergy Search process. He empathized with our frustrations and shared in our concerns for the difficulties we have encountered in finding a Priest in Charge.

He encouraged us in continuing our search, recognizing that we are in a period where there are far more openings for priests than there are priests looking for calls. (See the data below from the most recent Transition Ministry Conference). He encouraged us to be discerning in considering candidates that may present themselves to us through October 31.

The Bishop advised us that he will be appointing a part time lay employee to serve as the Transition Ministry Officer. That person will be named at the Diocesan Council meeting on September 26 and will succeed Canon Patrick Collins as our contact going forward.

The Bishop also assured us that he has a plan for our future clergy needs should we not find a suitable clergy person for our call by October 31. He is praying for us and will be working with us to secure the right clergy leadership for St. Paul's by-the-Sea.


