### **September Vestry Meeting Highlights**

- Approved the minutes of August 15, 2022
- The Clergy Search Committee reported that no candidates have expressed an interest in our Priest in Charge posting on the Episcopal Church Office of Transition Ministry (OTM) website. Bishop Marray has appointed Mr.

  John Dragone to serve as the Canon to the Ordinary and Transition Ministry Officer replacing Canon Patrick Collins who recently left.
- Tom Shuster reported on the meeting he and Bob Rothermel had with Bishop Santosh Marray on September 21.
- The Vestry Officers met on September 22 and formulated recommendations to the Vestry and Finance Committee for the 2023 Parish Budget. Vestry approved the recommendations. Cheryl will incorporate the recommendations into the draft budget currently under development by the Finance Committee.
- The Vestry reviewed and approved the Annual Diocesan Apportionment for 2023 in the amount of \$25,532.28.
- The Vestry designated October as "Heritage Month" in the parish and selected Sunday, October 16 as "Heritage Sunday". All parish members, past and present, are invited to return and reconnect to the parish family that Sunday for a special celebration of the Holy Eucharist, followed by a fellowship reception in Dewees Hall.
- Bob Rothermel reported that he has proposals for the improvements to the lighting in the sanctuary and chancel, and the installation of electronic chimes in the church steeple. These projects were previously approved by the Vestry in the 2022 Capital Projects list.
- John Knotts presented the Treasurer's report as of August 31, 2022.
- Paul Rogers presented the 2020 and 2021 Financial Review and Audit reports.
- Cheryl Nottingham presented the 2023 Stewardship Campaign proposal. The Vestry approved the campaign with the theme "Honoring Our Heritage; Embracing Our Future" to commence on Sunday, November 6 with a goal of \$70,000. Cheryl also reported that the next Finance Committee meeting will be October 24 at 5:30 pm via Zoom.
- The Vestry confirmed the plans for a Parish Gathering at Windmill Creek Winery on Friday, October 14 from 5:00-7:00 pm and agreed to provide a food coupon for participants to use at the food truck on premises.
- Vestry received a Communications Report from Jody Farley that included an update of the redesign of our parish website and the new Shepherd's Crook Logo.
- Set the next Vestry meeting for Monday, October 10, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. at church.


parish gathering at Windmill Creek Winery (11206 Worcester Highway, Berlin - slightly north of the SPBTS Community Center).
