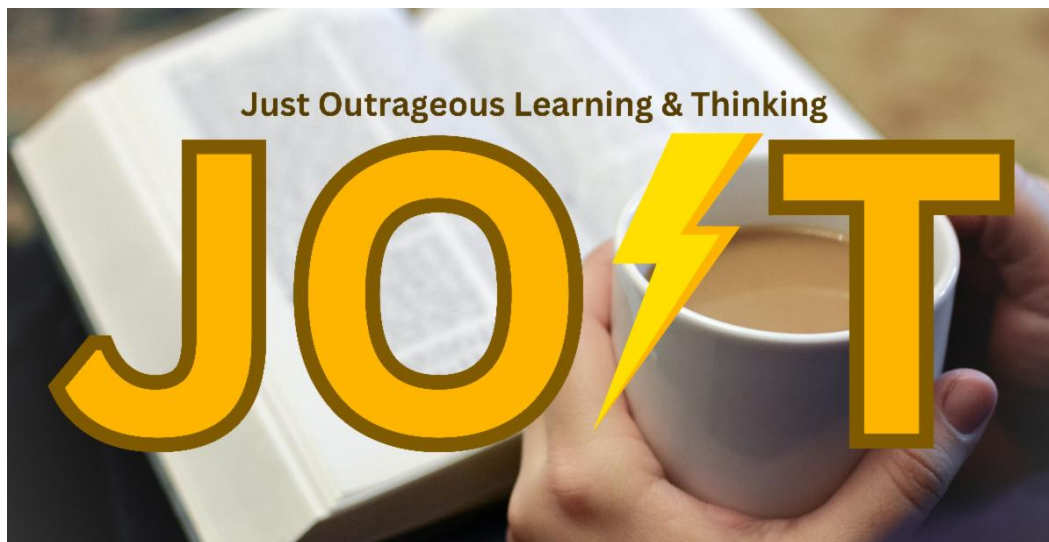


Generous Donation Received

A Place To Be

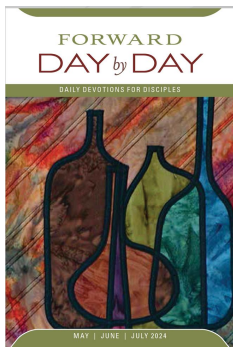
We have begun opening Dewees Hall on Tuesdays from 12 to 4, and are calling this time A Place To Be. It's just a place to be,
